University of Cambridge – Law – Yr12 and Yr13

University of Cambridge are launching a couple of outreach initiatives, designed to help prospective students to feel more confident about choosing law as a path and in making a competitive application to whatever university they choose to apply to.

To this end, they have some opportunities for students who might be considering pursuing legal studies or a career in the legal field.

They are hosting a free webinar series, Exploring Legal Futures, which offers seven

The dates for 2024 work experience are 8-12 July or 15-19 July. Students would be from Monday-Eriday, 10am-4pm


with us for one week from Monday-Friday, 10am-4pm.

Our Work Experience is for anyone aged 14-18 looking to gain an insight into the backstage roles in a theatre. It is one intensive week, with a focus on technical and production. Participants will be introduced to light, sound, special effects, and stage management. They will get the chance to try out different backstage roles in our professional theatre space and will work together to design and produce their own technical installation, which is showcased at the end of the week.

Students don't need to be studying drama, performing arts, or even have visited a theatre before to take part. The week is mostly practical learning and they'll be really hands on with all the equipment, with a chance to try a bit of everything.
